Letters of Introduction. To the Editor of the Standard. Sir—The long letter you published containing the experiences of Mr. Josiah Welles in various parts of the globe and in the River Plate in particular, has no doubt afforded considerable entertainment to your readers.

In these days it is not, as in older times, when a sailing vessel crawled in now and again with fresh victims. It is a matter of four regular steamers a month, each bringing a new batch of 'a few lines' in favour of such and such gentlemen in the agricultural or pastoral interest, nine out of ten of whom it is impossible to serve, except financially, and that only through letters of credit, or something tantamount.

I would also remind Mr. Welles, that the habits of residents in Buenos Ayres are undergoing a transformation. Hospitality is a great virtue, but unfortunately it is a virtue most practised by the semi-civilized. In the advanced days, people do not, in Buenos Ayres, live in 'factories,' as I believe they once did in India and China, and for all I know, so still, in Shanghai, where Mr. Welles seems to have met with such marked attention.

Year by year, families live more separately, as they ought; and many now reside at a distance, in places accessible by 'rail,' that grand reformer of customs. If Mr. Josiah Welles will find his way out by the train to any of the quintas in the neighbourhood, he may be quite sure of a welcome that will make him forget his peculiar affliction, and, I think, regret his hasty animadversions on the intention of merchants to letters of introduction.
