CALIFORNIA

A BREVIA GIRA.—A Jew, living in a Hungarian village, went out to his de-votional exercises on the Day of Atonement. On leaving home he cautioned his daughter not to admit any one into the house. Soon after his departure a man asked for admittance, which the girl refused. The manservant, however, opened the door for him, and was immediately struck down with a hatchet. The robber then burst into the girl's room and bade her deliver up to him the property of her father and prepare for death, as he could not allow her to live, lest she should divulge his name to the authorities. In vain were her entreaties to spare her life. "Then, if I must die," she at last said, "let me rather meet a speedy death at my own hands than a slow, lingering, and painful one at yours." To this the villain consented, and, closely followed by him, she went to the shop, took down from the shelf a bottle, opened it, and carried it to her lips. In a trice the contents of the bottle were in the eyes and face of the robber; with a shriek of agony he sank to the ground. The girl was saved. The bottle contained oil of vitriol. The police, who had entered the house on the cry raised by her, found the servant wetting in his blood, and the murderer writhing in agony on the ground. The next day he died.
