way of sending it to the Brazil. English keeps this gold, and accounts for it by English manufactures. The States alone on compete in manufacture with England, and reduce the present highly extravagant prices.

During the three years preceding the introduction of steamers into the Brazil, the increase in English imports into that country was less than 1-10th and during the three years which followed that important measure, it rose as high as 100 per cent.

These steamers would require a subsidy from Government, as it has been found from experience, that no line of steamers can subsist without an annual allowance from Government.

The expenses of the round voyage from Rio de Janeiro to New York and back of a steamer of 2000 tons exceed 20,000. If the governments of the two countries wish to foster a large trade, they must protect their citizens in establishing a line of steamers, and it is disgraceful to the two countries that all their transactions must be carried on by way of England or France.
