LOCAL EVENTS. San Juan—Owing to new postal arrangements, correspondence and passengers will soon be able to go to San Juan and San Luis direct, instead of at present by a roundabout way through Mendoza.

San Nicolas—This place seems to be anything but a garden of Eden. The citizens have applied to Government for licence to carry arms, on the ground of their fearing for their lives.

As it ought to be—Don Federico Suarez, and Don Manuel Villano, Crudo and Cocido, in Chilivcoy, laying aside their political differences, have jointly appealed to the Provincial Government for assistance to build a school in that town.

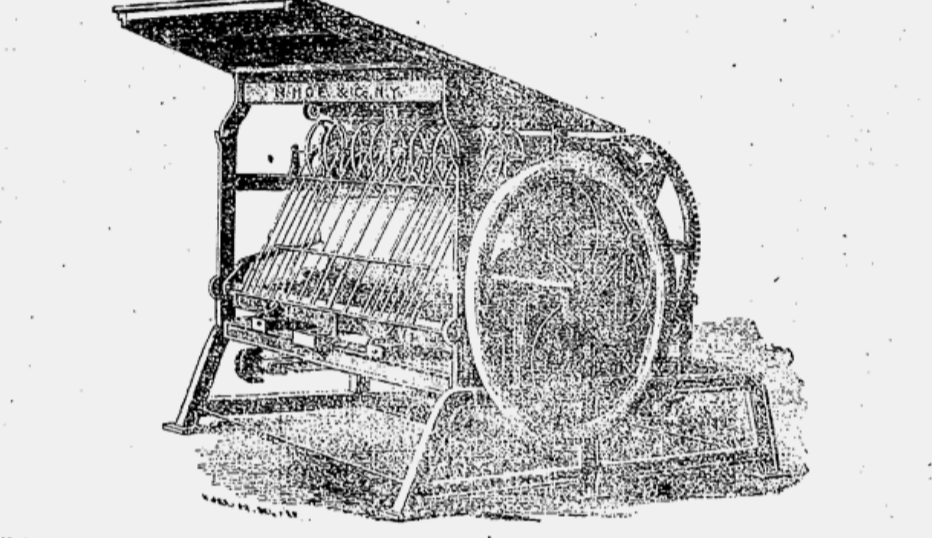
