CONDITIONS.

The interest allowed is six per cent (6%) per annum which is liquidated every six months. 3rd. The depositor can at any time retire the whole or part of the money deposited. 4th. 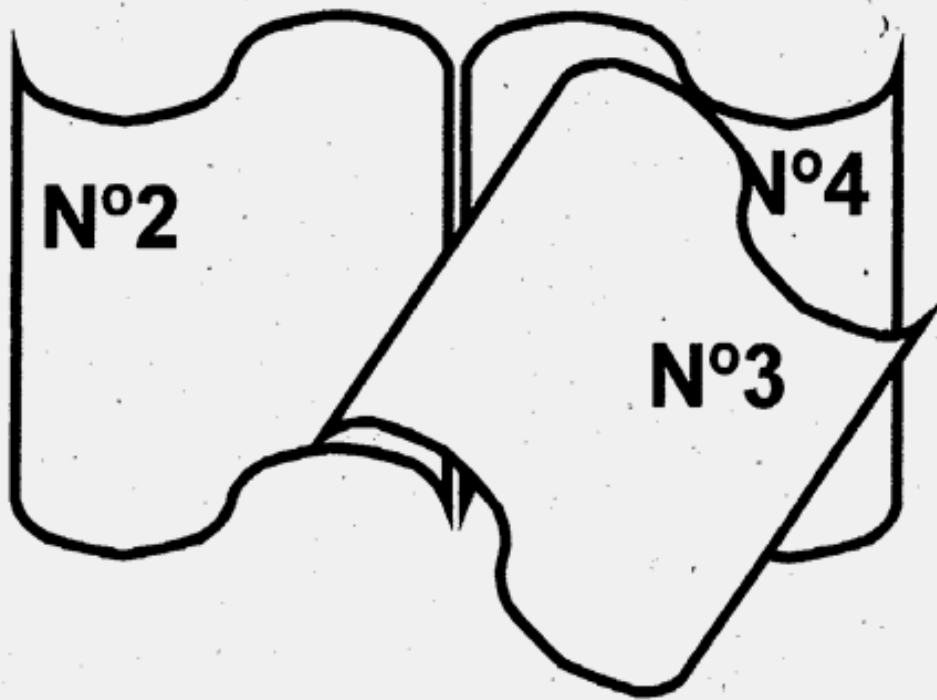
